I am writing to you today to thank you for your efforts to introduce the Snoqualmie Pass Land Conveyance Act, HR5999, which will help assist the Snoqualmie Pass Fire & Rescue agency by providing land for a new fire and rescue station.

The Bellevue Fire Department serves as the Advanced Life Support provider for the Snoqualmie Pass area and thus works closely with Snoqualmie Pass Fire & Rescue on a regular basis. We understand passage of H.R. 5999 will enable Snoqualmie Pass Fire & Rescue's to re-locate their station closer to I-90, which will in turn benefit thousands of motorists, tourists, truckers, commuters, outdoor enthusiasts, etc. that pass through Snoqualmie Pass on a daily basis. Access to Interstate-90, the location of most emergency medical and fire responses within the Fire District response area, would be greatly improved.
